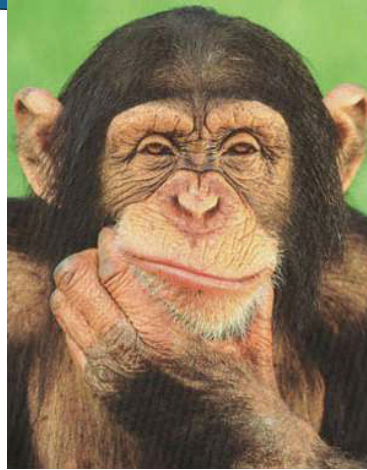


April: WEEK TWO
